# Virtual Online Safety Event

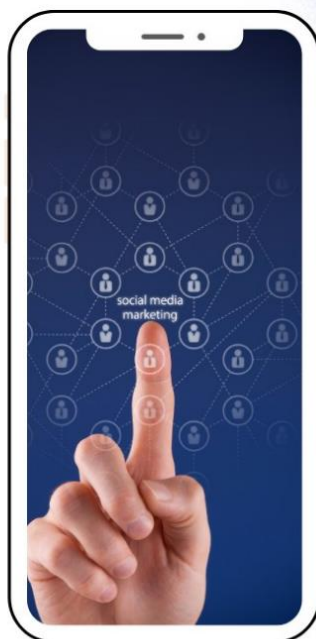
Calling all parents and carers from Cogenhoe, Bozeat and Irchester Primary Schools.
