Early Years Update for Parents

We have been advised by the Local Authority that from April 2024, new funding streams will be introduced to families to help with childcare costs.

- From April 2024 up to 15 hours funding will be available for eligible working families with a 2 year old
- From September 2024 up to 15 hours funding will be available for eligible working families with a 9 month old
- From September 2025 up to 30 hours funding will be available for eligible working families with a 9 month old up to school age

The funding currently available to 2 year olds who are disadvantaged or vulnerable will still be available.

The new funding streams are not Universal funding and not all families will be eligible. Please direct any queries regarding eligibility to Childcare Choices in the first instance to: https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/

As and when the school receives updates from the Early Years Team we will forward these to parents. The school continues to accept children into the Pre-School from the term after their third birthday.
