## NTFC Covering the Distance Event

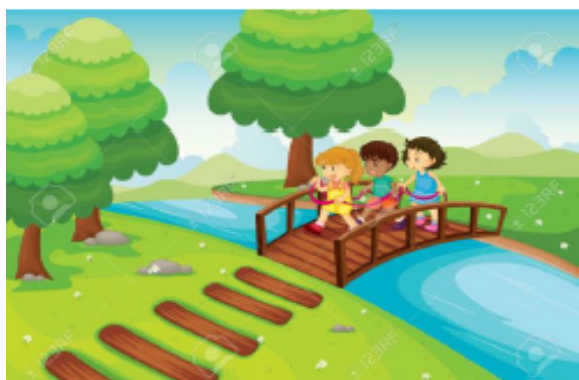
Damon Fox from Northampton Town FC Community Trust is completing a running challenge called 'Covering the Distance' whereby he is completing 750kms over 12 weeks for 7500 children in poverty in Northampton.

As part of the challenge, he would like to run a mile with as many children across the NTFC Community Trust partner & PASS Schools as possible. He aims to run a mile with both KS1 and KS2 Children over an hour period whilst at Bozeat Primary School on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

For the next half term we will continue to restrict numbers for the After School Club to 8. Places will be allocated on a first come first serve basis and must be booked on-line through the School Gateway system.

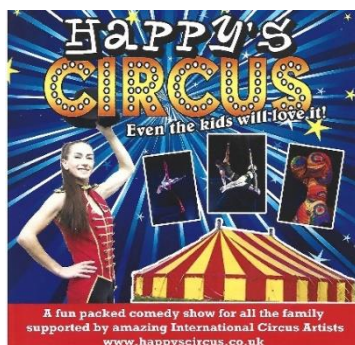
Breakfast Club and After School Club Bookings for Term 6 will open at **7.00am on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2023.**
