Explore the churchyard

Ideas from the conservation group for exploring nature in the school holidays- we only ask that you stick to paths and don't trample down areas of long grass as that makes it very difficult to cut later

*What can you find to look at in our Magnifier (by the seat in the corner)

*How many grasshoppers can you find in 5 minutes?

*Find a spider's nest – are there any spiderlings inside?

* Identify 3 different butterflies (iRecord butterflies or Big Butterfly Count apps useful here)

*Collect 10 different shaped leaves on a pointed stick

*Make a Rainbow – a small piece of card covered with Prit stick, or similar, to create a rainbow of colours

*What bugs are under the stones or logs (please be gentle and replace carefully, try not to touch as even small fingers can damage insects)
