We are having Christmas Jumper Day on **Thursday 7th December 2023**.

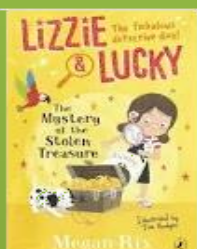
All staff and children can come to school wearing their festive jumpers to bring some Christmas cheer – no donation is required.

Advance Notice- World Book Day

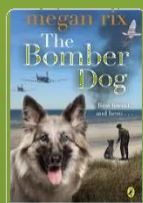
