Changes to After School Club and Reduced Fees

With effect from Monday 20th November we are changing how the After School is run on a trial basis in response to feedback from parents. We are now offering a short term stay option from 3.30pm to 4.00pm for parents who sometimes struggle to get to school for the end of school at 3.30pm.

Therefore, with effect from Monday 20th November 2023 the sessions available will be as follows:

- 3.30pm to 4.00pm: Stay and Play £1.00
- 3.30pm to 4.30pm: Late Afternoon Club £2.00
- 3.30pm to 5.30pm: Early Evening Club £4.00
- We will continue to provide a light snack to those children who want it between 3.30pm and 4.00pm
- We are also increasing the capacity to <u>12 children</u>

On-line bookings will only be available for children in Year R to Year 6. For those children on Little Owls who require a place at Pre-School please phone the office to book your place. This is to ensure that we can arrange for the correct staffing to be in place for our younger children.

All existing bookings will be amended to take into account these changes with effect from 20th November. Any resultant credit will be held on your account for future bookings.
